

We steward contributions efficiently and effectively, invest the vast majority of donor dollars into our housing programs, and allocate only a small percentage of funds to overhead expenses. Our funders include individuals, corporations, foundations, and faith organizations, and we receive grants and no-interest loans from local government sources.






